

A Taste of the Old West

Named for "the cottonwoods" in Spanish, Los Alamos stands at the northern gateway to Santa Ynez Valley and is surrounded by farms, ranchland, and vineyards with beautiful mountain backdrops.

Bell Street, the city's main thoroughfare, is dotted with high quality dining, cozy tasting rooms, thoughtful antique shops, and various boutique lodging, including the historic 1880 Union Hotel.

Founded in 1876 by two ranchers who combined their land to form the city center, Los Alamos is conveniently located at the junction of Highway 101 and State Route 135, just a half-hour drive from Vandenberg Air Force Base and the California Coast.

SOLVANG

Famous for its old-world Danish architecture and delicious bakeries, Solvang remains a popular tourist destination for visitors from around the globe. But it's not just about the charming buildings and ebelskivers — this quaint town also offers plenty of boutique shopping and over 20 wine tasting rooms, as well as an array of local events.







SANTA YNEZ

Sometimes referred to as the "sophisticated cowboy town," this sparsely populated gem is marked by its vintage false-front buildings and 1800s flavor. Shops, saloons, feed stores, and the occasional hitching post make Santa Ynez a rewarding spot for those interested in history and a laid-back ranch lifestyle. Or, for those who want a little more spice, the Chumash Casino sits on the edge of town and hosts a variety of entertainment options. And of course tasting rooms are never far away as well.





LOS OLIVOS

Small-town charm is packed into this wine tasting oasis in a big way! The extremely walkable and culturally rich Los Olivos was originally part of the stage coach route running from San Francisco to San Diego. Today it offers a wealth of antiques, local art, restaurants, festivals and — of course — wine tasting.







BUELLTON

Buellton is surrounded by miles and miles of wide-open space and borders the Santa Ynez River to the south. Convenient situated at the junction of Hwy 101 and State Route 246, this charming town is a great stop for travelers — especially those seeking a bowl of famously delicious pea soup.
