

THE NEIGHBORHOOD

ARTS & THEATER DISTRICT

Located in the heart of downtown Santa Barbara's Arts & Theater District, the subject property is central to numerous businesses, restaurants, and entertainment venues.

Around the corner, the Santa Barbara Public Market is a bustling complex of food and drink purveyors who embrace local, sustainable food practices. Two blocks down State Street, La Arcada is an outdoor mall filled with top-notch restaurants and boutique-style retailers.

The subject property is surrounded by cultural landmarks and venues, with the Arlington, Granada, and New Vic Theaters just steps away, while SOhO, the historic county courthouse, and the Santa Barbara Museum of Art are within a few blocks.


